Anyone interested in helping produce this great show is welcome to come



Comfort Quilt Convenors Nancy Wallace, Janice Hewitt & Judy Elliott

Comfort Quilts has been a fundamental part of the Trent Valley Quilter's Guild since it's inception in 2003 by Marilyn Payette, Joy Forge and Marilyn Edmunds. They headed up the Comfort Quilts Committee for approximately 16 years and they are still contributing to this group today.

Comfort Quilts have been and continue to be distributed to people in need, whether it's an individual with a serious illness, displaced families who have lost everything from a house fire, the Children's Aid Society or those immigrating from worn torn countries and the list goes on. Comfort Quilts meets twice per month, the 1st Wednesday of each month in Brighton and the 3rd Thursday of each month at Frankford United Church (61 Mill St). We start at 9:00 a.m. until around 3:00 p.m. at both locations. Attendance averages about 10 to 15 ladies per month.

Today I am here to ask you to consider joining our fun group for a day of sewing, socializing, and having lunch together. Coffee and tea are provided. It's not only to make quilts for others, it's to make new friendships and share stories and ideas, be it quilting or otherwise.

There are many ways that you can participate: if you want to sew a quilt, we have a very large

There are many ways that you can participate: if you want to sew a quilt, we have a very large stash of fabric to choose from – you don't have to use your own fabric – unless you want to. If that's what you choose to do you would be required to bring your sewing machine. Your completed quilt top is then passed on to be layered by the quilt sandwich ladies – usually Marion Payette and Cathy Herrington! Batting and backing is also provided by Comfort Quilts. Binding needs to be made or you may be asked to sew backing pieces together. We also need people to quilt the quilts – either by domestic machine or on long arm machines. You choose what you want to do!

Your hand won't be slapped if you don't attend meetings at both locations. We want you come to Comfort Quilts because you want to be there to contribute to a very worthwhile cause, while enjoying yourself in the process. If anyone, especially new members, have any questions about Comfort Quilts, please come back to the comfort quilts table and speak to me, Janice Hewitt or Judy Elliott. The Guild is a group 160 or so strong so we respectfully hope to see some new faces at future meetings. Thank you.

She also gave two hour lessons every Friday on the Hawaiian style appliqué. There is a sample in the left corner of the window. Of course I couldn't leave without purchasing something! I bought a Sylvia Pippen kit of a wall hanging that includes Sashiko stitching. Near the airport on the way home we took a 'wrong' turn and came across another fabric store selling Hawaiian fabrics that were selling for \$5.99 a yard for cottons and had polyester blends too. It was a great way to end our stay there.
